Pastor's Update

I am writing this update as we embark on Holy Week. Yesterday was Palm Sunday when Christ entered Jerusalem with the crowds hailing Him as king. However, they had an expectation of what His kingship would be like. They had seen Him heal the sick, feed the hungry miraculously, and even cast out demons. They hoped Jesus would free them from Roman occupation and take care of all their physical needs. Yet, Jesus came to earth as a sacrificial lamb. He would die on the cross later that week and atone for our sins. He came to deal with our deeper spiritual needs. He came as King of hearts first, and when He comes back the second time, He will exercise His authority as King of the world.

I wonder if we still act like that crowd on Palm Sunday. We look for Jesus to be the one to simply take care of all our physical needs. We relegate Him to the role of personal attendant rather that king of our life. Take some time this Holy Week and ask the Lord to examine your heart. See if you are seeking Jesus as king of your heart or merely looking for someone to solve your physical problems. Let Jesus reign as King of your heart!

During our congregational forum on March 28 th, we discussed where we want to go as church. There were three specific areas that we want to see Cornerstone thriving in the future. We want to be a church where people actively SERVE our community and church body. We want to be a church where we intentionally BUILD and develop disciples of Jesus Christ. We noted that there are at least 8 key attributes of a maturing disciple of Jesus. These attributes include: Bible engagement, obeying God/denying self, serving God and others, sharing Christ, exercising faith, seeking God, building relationships, and being unashamed. We long to see these attributes grow and develop in the members of Cornerstone. Thirdly, we want to be a church where we effectively REACH the lost in our sphere of influence. Finally, we asked what qualities and skills would be needed in the next pastor to help us fulfill this vision.

We would love to hear your thoughts on any of these areas. What are practical ways we can **SERVE** our community on a consistent basis? What areas do you feel you need to be **BUILT** and developed as a disciple of Jesus? How can we as a church help you **REACH** the lost in your life? What do we need in our next **PASTOR** to help move us toward that vision?
